**KARLOVY VARY INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL
plus PRAGUE (CZECH REPUBLIC)**

Founded in 1946, the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival is one of the oldest film festivals in Europe, and is the most important international film festival in Central and Eastern Europe. It is known for its young, enthusiastic audience which generates the festival's lively atmosphere. Karlovy Vary is a charming spa town located about 2 hours west of Prague. The whole festival is concentrated in the historical part of the town, along the river and spa promenade.

After 6 nights in Karlovy Vary, we continue on to 3 nights in magical Prague, to delight in exploring and discovering the „Golden City of 1000 Spires“. Our visit will include walking tours of Old Town and the Jewish Quarter, plus the Castle District and Prague Castle.
